Medical Evacuation and Repatriation

When a medical emergency requires specialized care, we coordinate transportation to the nearest center of medical excellence and monitor the member until discharge and/or return home. We will also repatriate a member back to their primary residence, school campus or original location, based on what's medically appropriate for the member.



Repatriation of Mortal Remains

In the unfortunate circumstance that a member passes, we will pay the necessary expenses for the preparation of the body for burial or cremation, and for the transportation of the remains to the member's residence or place of burial.



Emergency Family Travel Arrangements

We know being injured or sick in a foreign country can be overwhelming. We will coordinate airfare and lodging for a family member to the place of hospitalization when a medical or psychological hospitalization lasts more than seven days. If a dependent child is evacuated, one economy round-trip airfare will be provided to a parent or legal guardian regardless of the number of days that the dependent child is hospitalized.


